



Range Rules

Firearms:

- All firearms must be cased and UNLOADED when transported into the store, including magazines!
- Before entering the range with the unloaded firearm, it must first be inspected at the range check in counter. At this point any firearm(s) that is to be used on the range may be inspected for operational and mechanical safety.
- Firearms and magazines must remain unloaded before entering the range.
- Multiple firearms are permitted in the range; however, they must be unloaded and cased until they are used. Only ONE firearm at a time may be on each lane's shooting table.

Targets:

- Hendershot's Range and Training Center (HRTC) has multiple target types available for purchase. Any of these are acceptable for use on our range!
- Shooters may bring their own targets for use at HRTC as long as they are deemed appropriate by the duty Range Safety Officer. Please nothing offensive or obscene (We reserve the right to determine what is deemed not appropriate). HRTC strives to be a family friendly atmosphere!

On the Firing Line:

- Up to two (2) people may share a lane at any one time. Only one person may shoot at any one time in each lane and the participant that is not shooting must stand well behind the observation line.
- The ONLY exception is parents must accompany minors under the age of 18 at the firing line.
- BE AWARE OF YOUR MUZZLE AND ITS ORIENTATION! If you muzzle sweep the line you may be asked to leave the range.

- If you experience a malfunction or have a problem while on the range that requires assistance make your firearm safe or leave it on the bench with the muzzle facing down range and ask the Range Safety Officer on the line for assistance.
- Please ***no photography or videography*** in the range by unauthorized personnel. Distracted shooting is negligent shooting!
- Muzzles of ALL firearms must be pointed downrange at ALL TIMES!
- Chamber flags must be used in firearms that are not being used and ARE NOT cased.
- Shooters are responsible for loading and unloading their own firearms. If assistance is needed or a malfunction occurs, please signal the duty RSO by raising the non-shooting hand and keeping the muzzle pointed downrange.
- Range Safety Officers (RSO) on duty will supervise range activities and have direct control over participant's actions. The range officer may remove and/or ban any person that participates in unsafe or careless behavior. HRTC is here to make sure everyone has a fun and SAFE experience!
- Drawing from a holster is only permitted by those that complete a short and simple qualification process. Once you have your holster qualification, notify the RSO that you will be drawing from the holster during your firing session.
- Know your target lane and shoot only on your target (NO CROSS FIRE).
- Empty brass may be picked-up within your stall to the back wall. You may NOT collect brass to the left, right or in front of the firing line.
- If a shooter needs to leave the range for any reason their firearm(s) must be cased and given to the RSO on duty. When you return to the range the RSO will return the firearm(s).
- Due to potential lead hazards women who are pregnant will not be permitted inside the range.
- No smoking (vapor pens and E-Cigarettes included) or chewing tobacco of any kind may be used in the range.
- No food or drink is permitted in the range!

Protective Equipment:

- Impact rated eye protection is required to be worn at all times while in the range facility! Clear or amber lenses are recommended for indoor use.
- Ear protection must be worn at all times while in the range facility as well. Over the ear muffs as well as inner ear plugs are permitted. We recommend using both in conjunction with each other while using our indoor facility!
- Eye and ear protection must be put on before entering the range.

Clothing:

- Shooters must wear appropriate clothing that fully covers the chest area and shoes that do not have any open toe areas. Hot brass will be flying and can burn exposed skin if caught between the skin and clothing!
 - o No low cut shirts
 - o No tank tops
 - o No sleeveless shirts
 - o No open toed shoes

Permitted Firearms:

- Handguns in all calibers (NO BLACK POWDER!)
- Rifles up to .308 Win
- Shotguns (Only 00 Buck and slugs are permitted)
- Suppressors and SBR's (Must present paperwork for NFA items at check in!)
- Air rifles/Pistols with pellets only, no BBs.

Firearms NOT PERMITTED:

- Large/Magnum caliber rifles (May only be used on special rifle days)
- Fully automatic firearms (May be used on specific full auto days)

Ammunition:

- Reloaded ammunition is permitted
- NO penetrator, steel-core, tracers, armor piercing, incendiary, or explosive ammunition.
- If you are using aluminum or steel cased ammunition, please collect your shell casings before you leave the range.
- HRTC reserves the right to inspect ammunition any time!

Universal Safety Rules:

- Treat every firearm as if it were loaded!
- Never point a firearm at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- Keep the firearm on SAFE (if applicable) until you intend to fire.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
